THE ESSENTIALS

Arrivals and Departures

Check-in for Taupo Retreats is at 2pm and check-out 10am. We do appreciate most guests will be travelling from out of town and we'd like to accommodate your needs, please request time changes in advance.

The Keys

Before you are due to arrive we will be in-touch. It's our preference to meet guests on-site and do a quick hand over, but this isn't always possible. On departure please leave the key in an agreed spot.

Maximum number of guests

Taupo Retreats sleeps 12 guests (including children) and we request no additional guests stay above those agreed numbers. We have two family dogs and love pets, if you would like to bring yours please seek approval in advance.

Parties

Parties and events are welcome, but only with prior approval. Unfortunately, Taupo Airbnb guests have had some bad press in recent times, and this is not something we want to replicate at Taupo Retreats.

Neighbours

Please remember this is our family home and we are surrounded by GREAT neighbours who we want to remain happy. Please keep noise to a minimum, especially loud music and conversation outside after 10pm at night.

Smoking

Smoking is not permitted inside the home.

Breakages

Accidents do happen. Whether it's glassware or a window please let us know. You won't necessarily be charged for the item (unless it is substantial) but, to homeowners it's common courtesy.

Security

We request that all doors and windows are locked when you are away from the property and on check-out.





HEATING

We've got this covered with a generous gas fire in the living area & an open fire in the 'winter' lounge plus, there is ducted heating and air-conditioning throughout.

CENTRAL HEATING

The controls for this are on the right-hand side at the beginning of the bedroom wing. There are two controls, the right for the living wing and the left for the bedrooms. They are both currently set to 22 degrees, please do not alter any of the settings or the temperature as it's an easy system to disturb. We recommend you turn off the living wing at night as it quickly heats again in the morning.

GAS FIRE

The remote for this is kept under the TV. Keep your finger pressed down on the 'on' key to light and turn off. Please do not turn this up too hot, as it can overheat the TV above.

OPEN FIRE

Please always use the fireguard. Matches and fire starters can be found in the basket next to the fire. There is a pile of firewood and kindling under the veranda in corner of the central courtyard. Additional firewood is located next to the garaging at the rear of the property. There is also a bucket for ashes next to the fire and newspaper can be found in the left-hand draw under the TV.

HEAT PUMP

There is a heat pump upstairs for heating and cooling.

The password for this is: 344344 This mobile is not connected to a network and is only available for you to use while you are in residence on wifi. It's all hooked up to the SONOS sound system with Spotify playlists ready to play.

SONOS SOUNDS

Play your own Spotify playlists. To connect your phone to the system, follow these instructions:

On iOS or Android

- Open the Sonos app.
- From the settings tab, tap services
- Browse the list of available music services and tap the one you wish to add
- You can also tap on the search icon on the top right corner to manually search for the service you are looking for. Tap add to Sonos.
- Follow the onscreen instructions to add the music service account.

On MAC or PC:

- Open the Sonos App.
- In the music source section, click on add music services.

There is a vast collection of books on the bookcase in the hall and cookbooks in the kitchen.

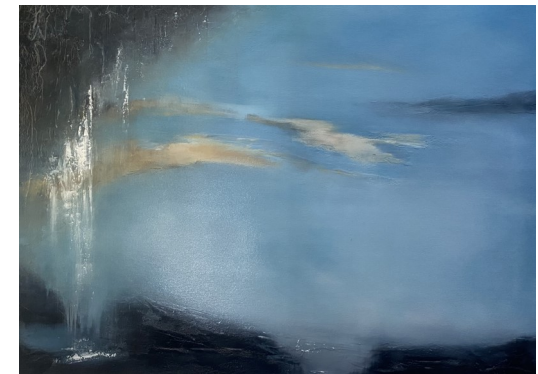
Games

KITCHEN & SCULLERY

The open kitchen features chef-grade appliances and a stunning XL marble island prep area, plus a caterer's scullery. We want you to make yourself at home and enjoy it all. Please take advantage of this and help yourself to all equipment and supplies (excluding alcohol!). If you enjoy cooking, now might be the time to leaf through the stacks of cookbooks and try out some new recipes.

Zip

There is no jug in the kitchen, instead there is a zip in the scullery for constant hot water.

Dish draws

There are two of these, one located by each sink in the kitchen. Cleaning tablets are found in the cupboard under the main sink.



Tablemats & Tea Lights

These can be found in the second draw down of the chested drawers at the end of the hallway.

Herb Garden

Help yourself to the herb garden at the rear of the garage. Depending on the time of year sage, rosemary, Bay (to the right of the shed at the back of the property), parsley, and thyme all available.

Barbeques

There are three Weber BBQ's, one on the front deck and two in the courtyard. Spare gas bottles can be found in the garage.

Cordless Vacuum Cleaner

We don't expect you to clean... but black carpet shows up every mark, if this annoys you, there's a cordless vacuum hanging at the end of the scullery.



COFFEE FIX

If you love coffee as much as we do, you are in for a treat! This machine's brilliant, you'll be able to sip cafe latte's and take in the view.

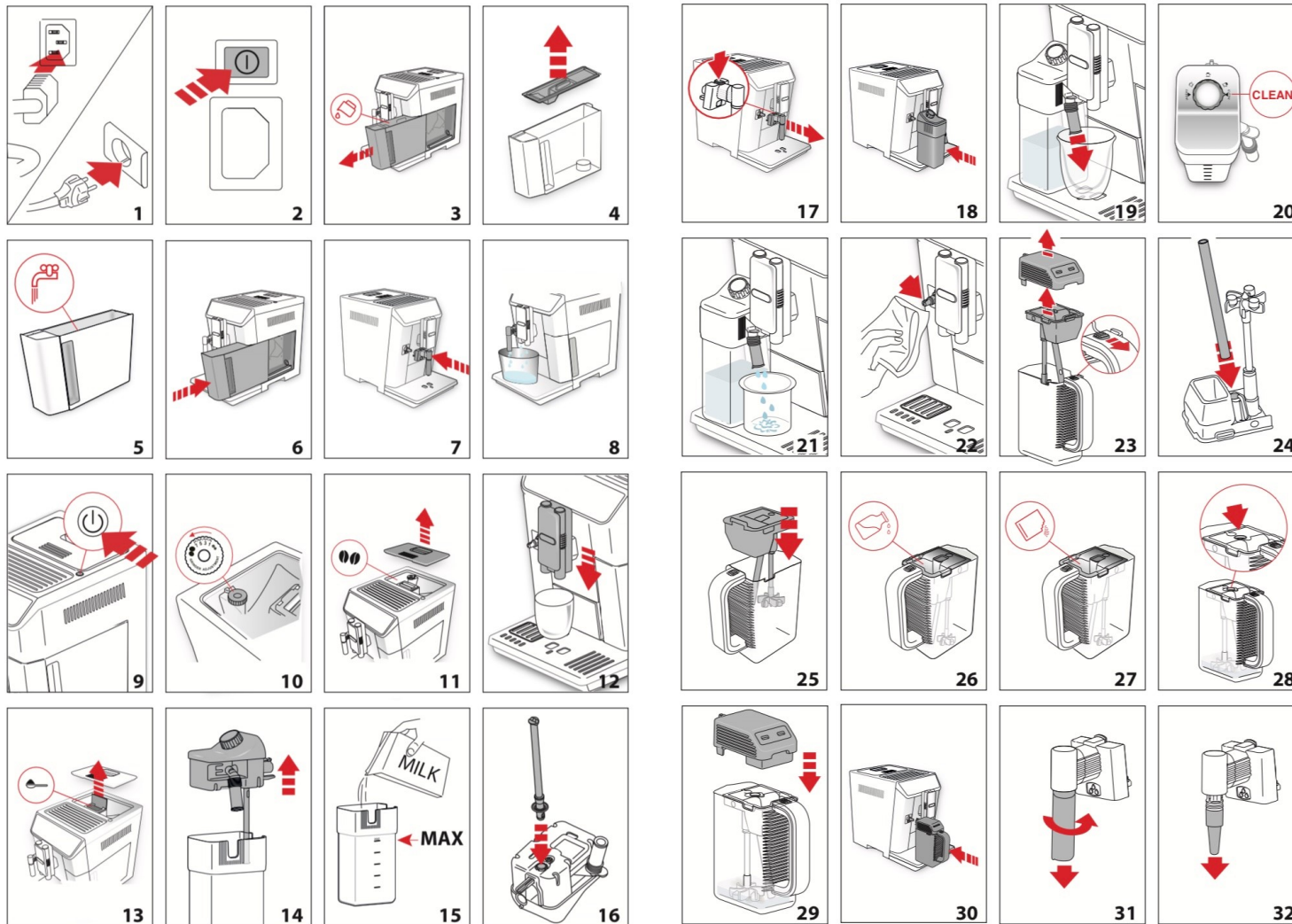
To fill and for placement of the components, follow the instructions.

To use, follow the instructions on the interface, or, if you feel inclined download the app: De'Longhi coffee link.

Coffee beans are kept in the drawer below the dish-draw.

Between uses store the milk canister in the fridge to keep milk fresh.

The machine will prompt you for more beans, water and to empty the grinds.





LINEN & LAUNDRY

The washing machine and dryer, both are straight forward to use. Detergent can be found in the cupboard above the dryer. If you are using the dryer the water canister in the top left corner will need to be emptied after a few loads.

Linen

We use commercial linen and towels when the property is rented out (this excludes duvet covers). If needed help yourselves to our linen which is kept in the large cupboard in the laundry. Dis-guarded commercial linen can be placed in the yellow canvas bags for return. It's not necessary to put linen in the wash on departure, if you would like to do anything, simply strip the beds.

Drying Racks

Depending on the season, these work well to dry washing. Please put them on the deck outside the laundry,

Towels

Extra towels and beach towels are in the cupboard in the hall of the bedroom wing.

Ironing Board

There's a fold out ironing board and the iron can be found in one of the top cupboards.

Duvet inners & extra pillows

Extras are in the wardrobe of the first bedroom

Warm Throws

There are a number of these in the top in the linen cupboard and they are brilliant if you are sitting outside on a chilly evening.

Garage

We request that you refrain from putting your car in the garage. You are more than welcome to use the toys and exercise equipment in this area.

First Aid and Hair Dryer

In the bottom left hand draw of the master ensuite.

DATE NIGHT

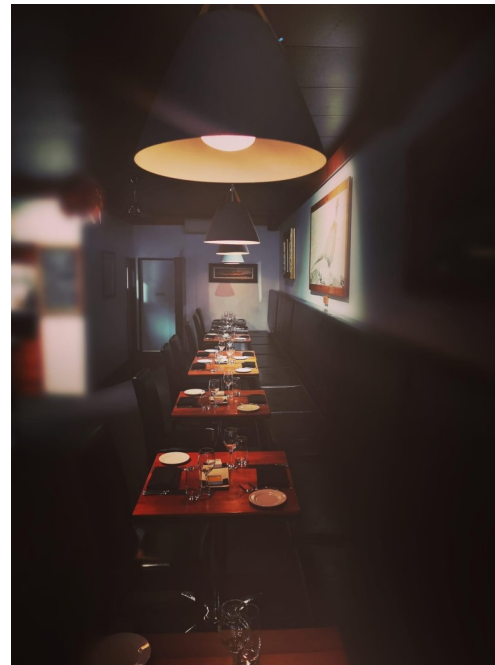
For something, a little more special head to Vine Eatery, The Brantry or The Bistro.
